The American Council for Construction Education (ACCE) is a 501(c)(3) private non-profit corporation. The mission of ACCE is to be a leading global advocate of quality construction education; and to promote, support, and accredit quality construction education programs. The primary goal is promotion and continued improvement of postsecondary construction education; specifically, ACCE accredits construction education programs in colleges and universities that request its evaluation and meet its standards and criteria.

ACCE is recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) as the accrediting agency for both 4-year baccalaureate degree programs and two-year associate degree programs in construction, construction science, construction management, and construction technology.

Organized in 1974 by the American Institute of Constructors, the constructor's professional organization, and the Associated Schools of Construction, ACCE enjoys the support of the principal building and contracting national associations and academic institutions seeking to satisfy the needs for well educated and trained entrants into the construction profession.

By working together under the aegis of ACCE, persons representative of the total construction community and the public at large, construction educators and constructors, establish and maintain standards and criteria for accreditation, provide guidance to those seeking to achieve accredited status, and carry out the accreditation and reaccreditation processes. In doing so, ACCE serves the interests of potential students by helping them identify institutions and programs that offer quality education in the field, and serves the interests of the industry by enabling employers to identify persons who, by reason of their education and training, have the potential for making lasting contributions to the industry and their profession. ACCE also serves the interests of owners/users of constructed facilities and the public at large by raising the professional caliber of constructors and thus the quality of the construction for which they assume responsibility.

ACCE has developed reciprocal agreements with the National Board for Construction Management Accreditation (NBCMA) of the People's Republic of China and the Canadian Technological Accreditation Board (CTAB). The agreements recognize university degree programs accredited by NBCMA, and CTAB as equivalent to Baccalaureate Degree Programs or Associate Degree Programs accredited by ACCE and the same equivalency for NBCMA, and CTAB accredited Degree Programs.

These agreements are the culmination of a long period of evaluation by all parties embracing academic standards' comparability, exchange of procedural information and reciprocal observation of accreditation visits.

As the construction industry goes, so goes the construction programs at colleges and universities and ACCE. The economy of the nation has certainly impacted all universities

and colleges across the country; the challenges of the construction slowdown have impacted budgets for our programs through the impact to the Industry Advisory Board-member companies and ACCE. There is light coming into the tunnel – we hope it is not an on-coming train!

During the fiscal year 2010-2011, ACCE has worked hard to continue its mission of promoting quality education:

* The entire Council has worked on improving the documents which govern and direct the operations of the Council. These changes mainly involve the Standards Committee; in addition, both the Guidance Committee and the Executive Committee have processed proposed changes which will receive the Board of Trustees' final vote at the February meeting in Phoenix.

* ACCE received a re-affirmation of our recognition from the Council for Higher Education Accreditation in January 2011. This 10-year recognition continues to reinforce the fact that ACCE is providing a high standard of accreditation review processes, outlined by CHEA and its 3,000+ university members.

* ACCE continues to work with the Army Corps of Engineers to push forward a proposal for the federal government to provide a professional series category for Construction Managers. This proposal has been submitted to the Department

of Defense to process and move up the chain, finally to the Office of Personnel Management for acceptance. This may take several years – we have taken the first few steps and will continue to pursue.

* ACCE will move forward to consider accreditation of its first Master Degree programs in the spring of 2012. This effort is after several years of dialog, 2 series of pilot projects and final Board approval.

In Ft. Lauderdale, our second Industry Advisory Board workshop/round table was held during our mid-year meeting February 24th. It success has been noted and our third workshop is scheduled for Phoenix February 22, 2012. The agenda continues to improve as does the participation from our industry. This is important, as ACCE has lost 2 additional construction association members. Continuing the balance of industry and academia is more important than ever.

ACCE awarded 2-\$5,000 scholarships in 2011. James P. Smith received the Dupree/National Housing Endowment scholarship and Manish Dixit received the Dupree Scholarship. Both these advanced-degree students are part of the Texas A&M CM Program

The National Housing Endowment received the 2011 Founder's Award for having a profound impact on construction education. The Endowments' grants through its H.E.L.P. grant program has provided over \$1.4 million to construction education programs, encourage and increasing the number of CM graduates going into the residential construction industry. This is in addition to the many thousands of dollars provided in student scholarships and for funding the initial Dupree/NHE scholarship for graduate students, focusing on residential construction with the intent of becoming

faculty in an ACCE-accredited program.

In 2010-2011, ACCE made 15 on-campus visits, with 12 re-accreditations and 3 initial (candidate) accreditations. The Accreditation Committee and the Board processed an additional 30 progress reports.

Today, ACCE has 67 4-year programs and 11 2-year programs accredited (total 78) with 12 and 9 candidates respectively.

As we look forward to the next year, I see the continued need for support from all our participants. With the changes we will implement in this period and the challenge to make sure we have a balanced involvement from both academia and industry, everyone involved with ACCE is needed. We are also working on the next evolution of our curriculum standards and looking at our processes to make sure we provide the best foundation for our programs to offer quality education and to know how to improve on a continuous basis.

We greatly appreciate and value every participant with ACCE. We thank each of you and know your work has a positive impact on the future of quality construction education.

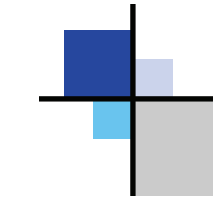

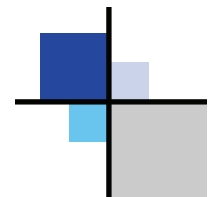

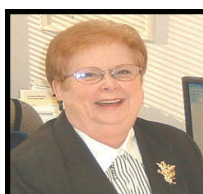
